Ann Wright is a retired U.S. Army colonel, a retired U.S. State Department official, and an outspoken critic of the Iraq war. She was one of three State Department officials who resigned in protest over the U.S. invasion of Iraq. Col. Wright won the State Department Award for Heroism for her assistance in helping thousands of refugees escape the civil war in Sierra Leone. She has been a long time peace activist and was aboard Challenger 1 as part of the Gaza Flotilla. Raised in Arkansas, she received a masters and law degree from the University of Arkansas and later was awarded a Master's Degree from the U.S. Naval War College

Larry Kerschner is a member of VFP-Korea Peace Campaign Steering Committee. He was in the U.S. Army as a U.S. Army soldier in the Vietnam War

John Kim is the Coordinator of VFP-Korea Peace Campaign and a former VFP Board member. He was a former U.S. Army soldier in South Korea.
