Drones and more drones. They are coming to a town near you, soon.

**Background:** As President Obama rapidly <u>escalates the use of hunter-killer drones overseas</u>, drone use here in the U.S. is also expected to grow. The <u>Department of Homeland Security</u> and even <u>local police departments</u> are now using drones for domestic surveillance. In February, President Obama signed a law requiring the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) to write rules <u>opening U.S. airspace to "unmanned aerial vehicles."</u> Some police departments are even exploring the option of using armed drones in U.S. cities.

**Take Action:** Local governments <u>have the power to restrict drone use within city limits</u>.

Introducing this ordinance to a governing body can be eased by working with other like-minded groups, and individuals from the community that understand the implications on our freedom and privacy, and the safety aspects of using drones, including crashes which can result in injuries, property damage, and deaths, and presenting the ordinance as a group to town meetings, or via petitions and introduction.

In addition, to assist in passage of the ordinance, it will be most effective to solicit people from the general aviation community, who already understand the safety implications of these UAVs invading their airspace, especially considering a lot of the smaller manned planes used by the GAC do not have radar and so forth.
