We conduct monthly zoom meetings, and when we meet in person VFP can and will help subsidize travel costs to ensure financial needs are not a barrier. For members who have difficultly traveling for any reason (e.g., due to work or family commitments), it is possible to attend in-person meetings by Zoom as well (which we have been doing through lockdown anyway). Will you have the time and availability to be an active member of the Board of Directors, join committees, and help with the duties and responsibilities of board members?

I'm an unemployed musician. Except for my camera not working (I will go to my puter-repair place and see if it can be fixed), I have this Zoom thing under control. And I don't know where we might meet in-person, but as a retired trucker, if it's really important I will drive it, and bring others if they come out of places down south.
