The Howard Zinn Fund for Peace and Justice seeks proposals from VFP chapters and members working on bold new approaches to building a peaceful society at home and peaceful policy abroad. Projects should challenge forces that lead to conflict such as **climate change**, the legacy and continuance of **colonialism**, **poverty**, and **militarism**, although we are open to funding any project that fits the VFP mission.

Please be sure to note in your application how you project plans to

1. Address structural and systemic issues in our economy and society, or

2. Create new structures and systems leading to peace at home and peace abroad

The Howard Zinn Fund for Peace and Justice will *not* fund projects which seek mainly to promote awareness of an issue or educate the public. We will not fund conference participation or speaking tours.

While we expect to fund projects with \$300 - \$500, we are open to providing larger grants of several thousand dollars if appropriate. Please note that funding is very competitive and many requests do not receive awards.

If interested, please either <u>complete the full application</u>, or write a short letter of interest to the Zinn Fund Committee, and we will guide you through the application process.

We encourage chapters and members to apply as soon as possible.
